Introducing a brand new 2025 65ft x 12ft Widebeam by Elton Moss – a breathtaking blend of luxury, craftsmanship, and modern comfort. Designed with full-time living in mind, this unregistered widebeam offers a flawless fusion of highend materials, thoughtful layout, and exquisite detailing throughout. With two stunning double bedrooms, a spacious open-plan living area, and designer fixtures at every turn, this boat is the epitome of life on the water – elevated.

Step aboard via the large, pram-covered square stern, where you'll find plush upholstered seating and a full-size removable table with Desmo legs – perfect for relaxing or dining al fresco. The stern also includes hydraulic steering, a neatly integrated control panel, two weatherproof 230v sockets, and a secure steel entry door, all illuminated by subtle exterior lighting for added convenience and style.

Inside, the galley kitchen is a true chef's haven. Equipped with twin stainless steel sinks, a multifunctional mixer tap, and a full suite of integrated appliances – including a full-size fridge, freezer, dishwasher, oven, grill, hob, microwave, and even a countertop coffee machine – it offers both form and function. The space is finished with elegant white quartz worktops, a breakfast bar with two stools, and an impressive range of storage solutions to keep everything tidy and accessible.

Flowing seamlessly from the galley, the lounge offers a peaceful space to unwind, with a large L-shaped sofa and a wall-mounted 43" smart TV. Built-in shelving and ample storage cabinets add both charm and practicality, while large thermal break double-glazed windows flood the space with natural light.

Guests are treated to a beautifully designed second bedroom, complete with a king-size bed, double wardrobe, bedside tables, a dressing table or desk, and generous built-in storage. The master bedroom, positioned at the bow, is a luxurious retreat featuring another king-size bed, twin double wardrobes, a dressing table, and a 32" smart TV. Double doors open out onto the cratch-covered well deck, which includes fully weatherproof, upholstered seating – the perfect morning coffee spot or sunset escape.

The bathroom is every bit as elegant as the rest of the boat, featuring a double shower with both a waterfall and detachable head, surrounded by a glazed pivot door that opens in both directions. A ceramic pump-out toilet and matching basin are mounted on a full-length quartz countertop, while a chrome heated towel rail and an abundance of storage keep things beautifully organised. Tucked away within a double-door cupboard is a full-size 9kg/7kg washer-dryer, seamlessly integrated into this sleek, functional space.

Constructed with care and precision by Elton Moss Boat Builders, this widebeam features a robust hull with a 10:6:5:4 thickness profile, protected by a two-pack epoxy coating and a bitumen sacrificial top layer. Stainless steel handrails, thermal break double-glazed windows, and refined finishes throughout speak to the quality and attention to detail of every element on board.
