The lounge is bright and spacious, centred around a multi-fuel stove with bespoke shelving built around it, creating a warm and inviting atmosphere. This area offers flexible seating arrangements and plenty of space to relax, dine, or entertain guests, making it the heart of the boat.

The first bedroom features a single high sleeper bed with storage underneath, ideal for a child, guest, or as a versatile space for hobbies or a home office.
