The thoughtfully planned stern-to-bow layout begins with a peaceful bedroom, flows through a compact corridor with bathroom access, and opens into a generous kitchen and lounge space—ideal for everyday living and entertaining alike.

Step into a bright and breezy galley that perfectly blends functionality with character. Framed by solid wood worktops, the kitchen is fitted with a charming ceramic butler sink complete with a chrome mixer tap, offering both style and utility.
